*Hey everybody! Mac here to warn you about identity theft. Here are some red flags that you need to know about!*

***Look out for unexplained withdrawals!***

If you see a strange charge on a credit or debit card, you may be compromised. Contact your financial institution ASAP!

***Note any collections calls on unfamiliar debts.***

A sudden burst of collections calls or mail notices may mean trouble that you didn't invite. Reach out to debt collectors for verification of the debt with a certified letter.

***Mystery medical bills.***

Check out any denial of benefits on approved medical treatments that your insurance company suddenly won't cover. Also, don't blindly pay for treatments or other medical services you did not receive, or from doctors that you don't recognize. Thieves can steal your medical information, too!

***Know the score!***

Check your credit report for any errors or inaccuracies that may have impacted your credit score. Any recent, unfamiliar credit inquiries or new accounts opened can be a sign of identity theft as well.
